




### Last Aspect: The Sun




### Informal view -- Orbit of the Moon and Earth

It takes about two and a half days for the Moon to cross one Sign of the Zodiac.








### Each month –

- The earth travels through one sign of the zodiac.
- From earth's view, the moon travels through all 12.
- Moving through signs, the Moon is telling a story.
- The pause at the end of the story is the void-ofcourse period of the Moon.
- At some point the Moon makes its last contact with another planet in the given sign—the end of the story.
- A new story starts when the Moon enters the next sign of the zodiac.



### Archaic point of view makes this idea work:

Moon travels through a sign with an 'assignment', the aspects made are her 'work'.

When the Moon finishes all her tasks (aspects), she cannot start on any new work -- must wait until she changes signs and receives a new assignment. Cosmically speaking, the Moon is 'out to lunch' from her normal daily routine.

The Moon rules the masses, daily routine, habits, instincts and personal patterns. It is the unconscious. From this perspective, when the Moon is void of course, our 'muscle' memory in these habitual tasks is interrupted.

- Personal freedom is most important to us




Note: VOC 1:35pm 10/20/15

## Psychological influence

Since the Moon is not making an aspect with a planet, we have no planetary events.



The void of course Moon periods are characterized by:

- Inconsistency
- Detached from reality
- Beneficial for the spiritual oriented people who will find this time as most auspicious for their spiritual endeavors



### What not to do during this time

The void of course Moon periods are most unfavorable to do anything:

- that require a specific desired outcome:
  - sending emails or faxes
  - applying for a job or contest
  - asking for favors
  - getting married
  - going out to date someone for the first time
  - starting a lawsuit or a business
  - announcing anything, buying important items such as a car, a property, etc.

The basic rule is: when you want something to happen, if you want to be successful, avoid the void of course Moon periods



### So, what is this period good for?

- Routine goes well, but take care when starting new projects.
- Organize and throw out the clutter:
  - get rid of the piles of papers and junk that have been accumulating
  - files may be reorganized, desks and closets cleaned out; it is easy during a void-of-course
     Moon to see what is needed and what should be discarded
  - Clear space to accommodate the Moon entering the next sign
- Sleep, do yoga, retreat, listen to music, have an impromptu party or trip (sneak away even for an hour)
- Put problems on hold. They will **feel** different when the Moon enters a new sign.
- Edit and correct: Writers use this time to revise their work
- Take stock of your surroundings: Shortages, mistakes, and missing items are more noticeable during the void.
- Make plans for things you don't want to do...they may fall through!


"John Kerry's 2004 nomination and Al Gore's 2000 nomination came in a Void of Course Moon"



#### **Waxing Moons**

A natural time each month for two weeks to begin, start and initiate projects.

Any Moon VOC here is still forewarned to not move forward for in an active way until the Moon enters the new sign for optimal results.



A natural time each month for two weeks to reflect, review, and reassess.


Any Moon VOC here is especially forewarned to not move forward for optimal results, as a "double layer cake of reflection" is being requested of us.

#### Mercury Retrograde

A natural three-week passage that occurs three to four times per year to reflect, review, and reassess.

As a Waning Moon phase accompanies it, a "triple layer cake of reflection" is in play. Starting any important venture under a Moon VOC when the Moon is Waning and it is Mercury Retrograde, is setting up the outcome for possible failure that could have otherwise been completely avoided.

### Traditional Astrologer's Use Many, Many Technical details, such as:

The void of course Moon period is only interrupted by Moon's aspects to the Part of Fortune (Pars Fortunae), a virtual point calculated by the formula Ascendant+Moon-Sun during the day (from sunrise to sunset) and Ascendant+Sun-Moon during the night (from sunset to sunrise). These ephemeral aspects last usually a few tens of minutes and are "astrologer's honor saviors", as they allow selecting a decent moment for a client to perform an action, during an otherwise negative period for action. Of course, this applies to the positive aspects of the Moon to the Part of Fortune (conjunction, sextile and trine).

William Lilly, a most reputed medieval astrologer, said that when the Moon is void of course in Taurus, Sagittarius, Pisces, and Cancer, it "performs somehow", that is when the Moon currently occupies a sign where a benefic planet (Venus or Jupiter) is exalted or ruler, it can lead to a favorable outcome in selected cases.
